Rev. Bianca Robinson Howard is a native of Portland, Oregon, but was raised in Atlanta, Georgia. She has served for over 25 years in ministry and was ordained in the Baptist Church. For 16 years, she served as the Associate Pastor of Children & Youth at Zion Baptist Church in Marietta, Georgia, and was the youngest female ordained in the church's history. She is also the Founder / Owner of Next Generation Youth Ministry Consulting, LLC., which partners with churches to consult in all their children, youth, and young adult ministry needs, such as training and coaching youth leaders, workshop facilitation, hiring support, and curriculum design.

Rev. Howard is a graduate of Valdosta State University with a BFA in Communications and received her M.Div. from Howard University School of Divinity and a Th.M from Princeton Theological Seminary. She is currently completing her Doctor of Ministry degree at Fuller Theological Seminary in the area of Youth, Family, and Culture. In 2019, Rev. Howard earned a Certificate in Innovation & Youth Ministry through Princeton Seminary's Institute for Youth Ministry. In 2022, she received another certificate through the Iron Sharpening Iron Woman's Leadership Program at Princeton and now serves as a mentor in that program.

Rev. Howard is a sought-after preacher, speaker, teacher, and consultant for churches, conferences, and organizations. Rev. Howard is an active member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., and is also a Board Member for Baptist Women in Ministry (BWIM). She is a part of a clergy couple and married to the Rev. Joseph T.
